

24K Gold Plated - This means the plating layer is 24K gold. It usually indicates electroplating. Vermeil - Means gold plated sterling silver or fine silver. It's regular old gold plating – except the underlying metal is sterling silver of fine silver instead of a base metal. If you're the type of person who appreciates vintage and antique jewellery, you've probably come across jewellery that's described as "Gold", "Gold Filled" "Gold Plated" or one of a dozen other phrases with the word Gold in it.
